Term 1 Examinations - Week 10

Term 1 Examinations are scheduled for Grade 7 to 12 in Week 10, Tuesday to Friday. Attendance is a must during exam week. As per our College assessment policy, no special exam is given outside the scheduled dates. If your child misses any exam, please communicate with the class patron and submit proof of evidence such as medical certificate and your child will be given an "estimate" mark. Exam schedule will be out next week.

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Kind Reminder to Parents How to Help Children Prepare for Examinations

- **Talk about examinations** It's helpful for your child to understand why schools give examinations and why it is important for their future.
- **Encourage your child to prepare early** studying for exams early means that your child gets to take time with revision and avoid last minute cramming or rushing through topics. Often when students do this, they find that they can't remember very much in the exam or their mind goes blank because the information isn't stored in their long-term memory.
- Make sure your child attends school regularly If your child misses' school, they are missing instruction that could help them do better on the exams.
- **Provide a place for studying at home** This could be the dining room table, a bedroom or a corner of the living room. Make sure the space is quiet and comfortable for your child to provide the best learning environment.
- **Establish a daily study routine** creating a study time table and organizing what to do during study period can affect their success on the examinations.
- Put away gadgets during study time and exam week Phone messages and notifications disrupt tasks like studying, causing information to be forgotten. Try encouraging your child to keep their phones away from their study area to improve focus. For example, you could suggest they place their phones in a different room or in a designated space where it is out of sight and reach.
